Students must earn a grade of C (2.0) or above in all courses taken for a major or minor in the German Studies Department.

1) Can be substituted by units from the successful completion of higher level German courses.

2) Satisfies Humanistic Approaches core requirement.

3) At least four additional units from the following: GERM 300, 305, 310, 315, 330, 420, 450; CONN 330, 333; HIST 224, 317, 320, 322, 325, 335; P&G 321. At least one of these units, but no more than two units, must come from GEM or CONN 330.

4) At least one semester in an immersion study abroad program in Germany, Austria, or Switzerland (with one year **strongly** recommended) or on a program in an Eastern European country that includes courses in the foreign language at some level (including Elementary). See bulletin for additional options if financial or personal circumstances preclude a student from studying abroad.

*Of the three units of upper division coursework required outside the first major, the Connections course will count for one unless it is used to meet a major requirement.

**A senior paper to be completed during a seminar course (GERM 400+) in senior year.

***Due April 1 of senior year. Student to seek guidance from a Faculty Advisor on creating a portfolio as soon as they declare their major.
